



OTU - COACH RPL ACCREDITATION CRITERIA FOR 2010

Back ground

The Oceania Taekwondo Union (OTU) has 15 member associations whose current and potential coaches have vastly differing experiences at their country level in terms of coaching opportunities and coaching experiences.

Due to these facts the OTU has determined that the Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL) and the proposed accreditation level of an individual coach will be simplified to ensure that no country or coach is disadvantaged in any way.

RPL Criteria

Therefore, in 2010 the RPL Accreditation of OTU coaches will be based on coaches past practical experiences at MNA level and at specified WTF sanctioned events.

RPL Accreditation Classes for RPL in 2010

There will be five (5) levels of accreditation that will assist countries to promote and encourage coaches to become further involved in the promotion of skills and experiences of their athletes.

S -Class - for all new coaches

N -Class - for coaches that have coached at a National Level event

Eg. MNA National Championships, MNA National Team Selection Trail, etc.

I -Class - for coaches that have coached at a WTF Sanctioned International Open Level event

Eg. US Open, Korea Open, Dutch Open, etc.

R -Class - for coaches that have coached at a WTF sanctioned Regional or World Level event

Eg. World Championships, World Cup, Oceania Championships.

O -Class - for coaches that have coached at a WTF sanctioned Olympic Qualification Level event or Olympic Games

Eg. World or regional Qualification Tournament and/or Olympic Games.

Note #1: All RPL coach applicants must provide 'proof' of coaching experience to the Class applied for.

Note #2: All RPL coaches will need to attend an approved OTU Coaching Course before the end of 2011 to maintain their accreditation status and to be eligible to coach at any level.
